Is there a "back-up" plan for the ceremony in case of inclement weather?

Absolutely. We have plenty of space to work with inside and out, including a beautiful indoor ceremony option.

Can we have a sparkler send-off?

WEDDING REHEARSAL

Is a wedding ceremony rehearsal time included in our use of The Manor House?

Yes, your Manor House event coordinator will be happy to facilitate your wedding rehearsal. The Manor House will likely be able to hold your rehearsal the day before your wedding (usually mid-morning). Please keep in mind that all rehearsals are scheduled around events. Because of this, rehearsal dates and times cannot be guaranteed until eight weeks prior to the event.

Is a rehearsal dinner included in our use of The Manor House?

A rehearsal dinner / lunch is not included with your ceremony rehearsal, but we'll be happy to recommend some excellent restaurants in the area.

DJ'S / BANDS

Please make sure to discuss the following requirements with your DJ prior to the event. Your DJ / band is responsible for all audio equipment and microphones for the event, including outside at the ceremony site. The Manor House does not provide any audio equipment or microphones. We have a sound system that plays background music in the areas your DJ / band may not be covering (i.e. foyer, patio, lounges, etc.).

We recommend a minimum of two sets of audio equipment: a first, smaller setup (including microphones) for the outside ceremony and a second, full setup for dinner/dancing).

Bands may request additional time for setup and / or breakdown. We highly recommend an all-day buyout to allow plenty of time before your event for setup. We allow one half hour of time after the event end time (usually 11 pm) for breakdown.

Do you require a food and beverage minimum?

Yes. Please see the first page of your event contract for your food and beverage minimum.

Do you offer plated service?

If you have selected a Guest Choice Plated dinner service, please remember to provide Individual name cards with an easy-to-read word, single letter or icon indicating the entree selection. If you'd like the name cards to guide your guests to their assigned table, please bring your escort cards to us in alphabetical order and we will stage these outside of the dining room. If you'd like us to pre-set the name cards at the dinner table, please assign a seat to each guest and please bring the cards to us grouped by table. You will also need to provide a seating chart sign to guide guests to their tables.
