Guest Choice Plated - Need to Know

If you are planning to give your guests a choice of entree (ie. Guest Choice Plated) you will need to provide your day of coordinator with a name card for each guest indicating their entrée selection. This can be done with a letter (i.e. "S" for steak / "C" for chicken) or an icon (i.e. a cow for steak / fish for salmon).

Please do not use color coding as it's difficult for our staff to see in dinner lighting. The name cards can also include a table number so they double as "escort cards" OR they can be pre-set on the dinner table as "place cards" (in this case, you would need to assign seats at the table.) This is not required for single or dual entree service styles!

With all service styles, a spreadsheet indicating your guests names, table #, meal selection, and allergies is required with submision of your final numbers.

Attached below is a template of what escort cards/place cards should look like! Please feel free to use this or create your own!
